## HOW TO SUBMIT WRITING TO EPOCH MAGAZINE

- Review your piece of writing with a peer editor and check that it's free of grammatical and spelling errors. Your piece should be 1,500 words or less.
- Attach your writing to an email and send to: [epoch@skidompha.org](mailto:epoch@skidompha.org)
- Acceptable file formats are .doc, .docx, or .pdf. We cannot consider hardcopies or files that are not in these formats.
- Attach a completed permission slip to the same email.
- Use "EPOCH Submission – YOUR NAME" in your email subject line.
- Include your name, school, grade, and a title for your submission.
- You can submit up to 5 pieces of writing and artwork for EPOCH Editors to consider per volume.

Submissions that do not meet our criteria or do not follow these submission steps will not be considered.

### Other General Guidelines / Notes:

EPOCH Magazine is a collaborative creative magazine between Skidompha Library and Maine teens in grades 7 to 12. All pieces are considered by an Editorial Board of volunteer students and mentors, and are reviewed and selected anonymously.

Our editors look for pieces that keep us interested, have minimal typos and grammatical errors, are well-crafted and contain unique content, and demonstrate your creativity. We ask that you send us your final draft; it's very helpful to have a friend, educator, or mentor review your piece with you before you submit to EPOCH.

Please note that we do accept pieces that have been published elsewhere (if the other publication also allows this), but please let us know where and when something was published previously so that we can add a note in our magazine.
