JULY

- **July 8 @ 10:30 AM: Picture Book Book Club**—Readers ages 6 and up are encouraged to bring a couple of their favorite ocean-themed picture books. Grabbing some from the Skidompha collection on the way in the door is totally acceptable and encouraged! We'll talk about the books, about why we love them, and share some favorite parts. *No registration necessary.*
- **July 13 @ 1:00-2:30 PM: Nature Walk @ Salt Bay Farm**—Maine Master Naturalist, Heather Hardy, will lead a 1.5 mile hike through the Salt Bay Farm & Nature Center and discuss local ecology, flora, and fauna along the way. *Registration required; 12-person limit; participants under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult.*
- **July 14 @ 10:30 AM: Watercolor Painting with Erica Qualey**—This ocean-themed class will teach painting techniques and help participants hone art skills. *Registration required; ages 5 and up.*
- **July 22 @ 10:30 AM: Mr. Drew and His Animals Too**—Join wildlife rehabilitator & educator, Mr. Drew, to learn about & see live exotic animals. This program features live animals and is sure to please the wildlife enthusiast in your family. *No registration necessary.*

AUGUST

- **August 2 @ 1:00-3:00 PM: Nature Walk @ La Verna Preserve**—Maine Master Naturalist, Heather Hardy, will lead a 2.5 mile hike through the La Verna Preserve and discuss local ecology, flora, and fauna along the way. *Registration required; 12-person limit; participants under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult.*
 - **August 5 @ 10:30 AM: Explore Tide Pools with Chewonki**—We're excited to bring Chewonki's Traveling Natural History Program back this summer! Tide pools are home to a variety of species with unique adaptations allowing them to maintain stability in a world that is in a constant state of change. Using this interactive traveling display, participants will dip their hands into the three zones of Maine's rocky intertidal ecosystem and touch some of the ocean's most magnificent species.
 - **August 10-11 @ 10:30 AM-12:00 PM: Small Scale Whale Machines**—This two-part class will combine engineering and art to help participants create a movable whale machine. This class is perfect for kids who love to tinker. *Registration required; ages 8 & up; must attend both sessions.*
 - **August 13 @ 10:30 AM: Marine Mammals of Maine: The World of Whales**—A representative from Marine Mammals of Maine will dive deep into the world of whales, covering topics from identifying different species to procedures for rescuing a beached whale. *No registration required.*
